Pursuant to sections 5101.141, 5103.03, 5153.166 and 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the following rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-42-19 entitled <u>Requirements for the Provision of Independent Living Services to</u> <u>Youth in Custody</u> sets forth the requirements for the provision of independent living services to each youth in custody who has reached the age of fourteen. This rule has been amended to clarify the process of amending the case plan for a youth age fourteen in foster care, include the guidance on credit checks from the credit reporting agencies and guidance for the counties to connect eligible youth to the Bridges program. In addition, minor changes for clarity and minor grammatical changes were made.

OAC 5101:2-42-19.2 entitled <u>Requirements for provision of independent living services to young adults who have emancipated</u> sets forth the requirements for PCSAs to provide services and support to emancipated foster care recipients. This rule has been amended to include guidance based on H.B. 50 for PCSAs to refer young adults to the Bridges program.
