Pursuant to sections 5101.1414 and Chapter 119.03 of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules to clarify policy relating to the administration of the adoption assistance connections to age twenty-one program as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-51-01 “Administration of the Adoption Assistance Connections (AAC) to Age Twenty-One” provides guidance for the administration of the AAC program.

OAC 5101:2-51-02 “Eligibility for the Adoption Assistance Connections (AAC) to Age Twenty-One” outlines the requirements that the adoptive parent(s) must assure they continue to provide parental responsibility for the adopted young adult, the adopted young adult also assures ongoing parental support, and the adopted young adult meets one of the five eligibility criteria.

OAC 5101:2-51-03 “Payments for the Adoption Assistance Connections (AAC) to Age Twenty-One” provides guidance on the payment process for AAC.
