The following rule is subject to five year review.

OAC 5101:2-33-20 OAC 5101:2-33-20 entitled PCSA complaint review and report disposition appeal policy sets forth the PCSA requirements for developing a written policy to receive, review, and resolve complaints and report dispositions. There were no recommended changes to the rule. However, the last paragraph referenced a rescinded rule (5101:2-33-05) regarding outdated PCSA documentation procedures. The language has been removed from the rule.
