Pursuant to sections, 2151.412, 2151.421, 5103. 03, 5153.16, 5153.166 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Amended Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the Department's intent to consider the amendment and introduction of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The following rule are subject to five-year review.

**OAC Rule 5101:2-1-01 Children Services Definitions of Terms** was amended to include the terms "family case plan", "candidate for foster care", "candidate for prevention services", "evidence based practice" and "prevention services plan" to assist PCSAs in identifying and providing prevention services to families.

**5101:2-36-10** entitled **PCSA Requirements for Responding to Family in Need of Services Reports** was amended to include the use of the "Family Assessment" for all family in need of services reports transferred for prevention services prior to the completion of the "Prevention Services Plan".

**5101:2-40-02** entitled **Supportive Services for Prevention of Placement, Reunification and Life Skills** sets forth the primary goals of all supportive services and was amended to add "Prevention Services" to the list of available PCSA services.

**5101:2-40-05** entitled **PCSA Requirements for Providing Family First Prevention Services** sets forth the PCSA requirements for implementing the Family First Prevention Services program to assist the PCSA in the provision of prevention services to families. This new rule outlines the prevention services program requirements for a PCSA in the provision of prevention services to families.
