Pursuant to sections, 2151.412, 2151.416, and Chapter 119. of the Administrative Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the Department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The following rule is subject to five-year review.

**OAC Rule 5101:2-38-04 PCPA requirements for completing the semiannual administrative review** sets forth the requirements that apply to a private child placing agency (PCPA) when completing a semiannual administrative review. The paragraph order has been restructured throughout the rule and language has been updated to reflect the changes to the family case plan. Language has been included to support additional time for case review approval after submission by a caseworker. Language was added to include the notification requirements of permanency team members for a child in a Qualified Residential Treatment Program (QRTF).
