Pursuant to sections,5101.141 and 5153.166 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Administrative Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the Department's intent to consider the adoption of an amended rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-47-21 "**Title IV-E Foster Care Maintenance (FCM) reimbursement for a child placed into a Qualified Residential Treatment Program (QRTP)**" outlines the reimbursement requirements for a child placed into a QRTP. The rule is being amended to remove paragraph (C). Public Law 115-123 states a youth is eligible for reimbursement in a non-QRTP for the first fourteen (14) days. However, for a youth placed in a QRTP, if the assessment is not completed within 30 days, the title IV-E agency cannot claim title IV-E FCM for the entirety of the QRTP placement (this exclusion applies to the first 14 days) but may claim title IV-E administrative costs during the placement in the QRTP.
