This rule is being amended as a result of the five year rule review requirements.

OAC 5101:2-47-04 entitled "Intercounty and interstate case management responsibility for foster care maintenance" describes the transfer of a child's foster care maintenance case (FCM) and the case management responsibilities for FCM when a case is transferred to another county. Minor changes were made to paragraphs (A) and (B) by adding the word "custody." Paragraph (C) was revised to add clarity regarding the child's placement in another state.
