Pursuant to section 2151.416 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Amended Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the Department's intent to consider the amendment of two rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-38-04 is entitled PCPA requirements for completing the semiannual administrative review.

This rule identifies the requirements for a PCPA when completing a semiannual administrative review. The rule includes requirements to review the concurrent plan. Language has been included to meet federal and state requirements established in ORC 2151.412.

OAC 5101: 2-38-07 is entitled PCPA family case plan for children in custody or under court-ordered protective supervision.

This rule identifies the requirements for a PCPA when completing a family case plan. The rule includes requirements for concurrent planning within the family case plan when a child enters temporary custody of a PCPA. Language has been included to meet federal and state requirements established in ORC 2151.412.

These rules are being amended to meet the requirement of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 5101.412. The amendment of these rules are necessary to ensure that requirements for implementation of Concurrent Planning are met within rule, and to secure the ability of agencies to include concurrent planning requirements within the Family Case Plan and Semiannual Administrative Review.
