Pursuant to sections 2151.412, 2151.421, 5103.03, 5103.13, 5103.54, 5153.166 and 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment and adoption of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon. The rules are being proposed as a result of five year rule review, HB 166 and HB 267/SB 167.

**OAC 5101:2-1-01** entitled <u>Children Services Definitions of Terms</u> is amended to include two new definitions, Family Preservation Center and Residential Infant Care Center, along with a reference correction for the definition of relative.

**OAC 5101:2-5-03** entitled <u>Certification of an Agency to Perform Specific Functions</u> is amended to provide guidance on the types of foster care certifications an agency may receive from ODJFS. Paragraphs (A), (C), and (D) were amended to add the new facility types of Residential Infant Care Centers and Family Preservation Centers.

**OAC 5101:2-9-36** entitled <u>Additional requirements for children's crisis care facilities</u> is amended to provide guidance for children crisis care facilities. The amendment is removing waivers from the rule and providing instruction to the facility providing an engagement plan to the parent or agency placing the child. The amendments include protective monitoring methods for sleeping infants and hygiene for children after bathroom usage, outside play and handling animals. Other grammatical changes have been made for clarity and correction within the rule.

**OAC 5101:2-9-43** entitled <u>Residential Infant Care Center</u> is a new rule and sets forth guidance with the primary purpose the provision of residential services for infants affected by substance use and the preservation of families through infant diversion practices and programs.

**OAC 5101:2-9-44** entitled <u>Family Preservation Center</u> is a new rule and sets forth guidance for a new certificate and prevention service for actively licensed Children's Crisis Care Facility or a Residential Infant Care Center.
