Pursuant to sections 2151.412, 2151.421, 5103.03, 5153.166, and Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

**OAC rule 5101:2-42-65.1** entitled **Exit Interviews when a Child in Custody Leaves an Out of Home Placement** outlines the requirement for an exit interview to be completed each time a child leaves a foster care placement. This rule has been revised to remove the requirement that the interview be completed only by a caseworker. Public Children Services Agency (PCSA) is revised to Title IV- E Agency throughout the rule. Section (E)(2) was also revised easing the exit interview requirement for placements of less than seventy-two hours, from the previous version of twenty-four hours
