Pursuant to sections 5101.141, 5103.03 and 5153.166 and Chapter 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rule or rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:2-42-19, entitled <u>Requirements for the provision of independent living services to youth in custody</u> is being proposed for amendment to reflect current standards in rule writing, streamline language for clarity and the list of available services were removed to allow for local flexibility. Additionally, clarifying language was added related to the National Youth in Transition Database and the Foster Youth Rights Handbook, and clarifications regarding use of Chafee Independent Living Allocation. Lastly, the requirements to complete readiness reviews and final transition plans were modified to reduce burden to PCSA caseworkers and allow for flexibility for youth that would not be emancipating at age 18 and the requirement to determine if a youth meets eligibility requirement for Bridges were removed. Rule 5101:2-42-19.2, entitled <u>Requirements for provision of independent living services to young adults who have emancipated</u>, is being proposed for amendment to reflect the current standards in rule writing, remove lists of available services to allow for flexibility for young adults who have emancipated up to age 21, and language was streamlined for clarity.
