**OAC 5101:2-39-08.2** entitled <u>Child's education and health information</u> also outlines the requirements for completing the JFS 01443 "Child's Education and Health Information" form as well as to whom and what information may be shared or disseminated. This rule is amended to include language which provides foster children aging out of the system with a copy of the JFS 01443 free of charge.
