Pursuant to sections 119.03, 5103.03 and 5153.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the new rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

This rule sets forth the new requirements of the caseworker when making visits to children in a substitute care setting. This rule outlines the provisions that govern the responsibility of the caseworker and the frequency in which visits must be made. The proposed rule clarifies the responsibilities of the caseworker.

OAC 5101:2-42-65 entitled <u>Caseworker visits and contacts with children in substitute care</u> outlines the provisions that govern the responsibility of the caseworker when making visits to children in a substitute care setting. This rule is being rescinded and filed as new to ensure Ohio's visitation policy promotes child safety and well-being while the child is in substitute care and that they meet the requirements of the federal legislation. Language was added that stipulates the caseworker's frequency of visits with children in substitute care as well as specific observations and activity during the visit.
