<u>OAC 5101:2-5-13.1</u> entitled <u>Disaster Preparedness Plan Requirements</u> is a new rule created to ensure public children services agencies, private child placing agencies, private non-custodial agencies and residential treatment centers develop and implement a disaster preparedness plan.

OAC 5101:2-33-26 entitled <u>The county child abuse and neglect memorandum of understanding</u> is an amended rule revised to provide clarity as to the delineation of the respective duties and requirements of all involved in the assessment/investigation of child abuse and/or neglect as specified in the memorandum of understanding (MOU). Additionally, the rule amendments include addressing the issues related to disaster preparedness as outlined in OAC rule 5101:2-5-13.1 within the county MOU.
