Rule 5101:2-33-55 entitled "Education and in-service training requirements for PCSA caseworkers" is being proposed for amendment to implement section 5153.122 of Sub. HB 7 of the 127<sup>th</sup> General Assembly. This rule sets forth the training requirements for public children services agency (PCSA) child welfare caseworkers. This rule has been amended to update the training requirements defined in the Ohio Revised Code regarding training for public agency child welfare caseworkers.

OAC 5101:2-33-56 entitled "In-service training requirements for PCSA supervisors" is being proposed for amendment to clarify the training requirements for PCSA supervisors. This rule sets forth the training requirements for public children services agency (PCSA) child welfare supervisors. This rule has been amended to update the training requirements defined in the Ohio Revised Code regarding training for public agency child welfare supervisors.

OAC 5101:2-48-20 entitled "Release of Identifying and Nonidentifying Information" is being proposed for amendment to implement section 3107.60 of Sub. HB 7 of the 127<sup>th</sup> General Assembly. This rule sets forth the procedures for releasing identifying and nonidentifying information about a birth parent. This rule has been amended to clarify that nonidentifying information shall be provided to the birth parent of an adopted person eighteen years of age or older and to expand the list of nonidentifying information that shall be provided.
