STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES

Pursuant to Section 5111.02 and Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code the Director of the Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to amend rule 5101:3-1-60 and of a public hearing upon the permanent rule.

Rule 5101:3-1-60 entitled <u>Medicaid reimbursement</u> contains provisions for reimbursing non-institutional providers. The appendix of this rule is being amended to discontinue local level codes that are not HIPAA compliant for programs including hospice and dental. HIPAA-compliant codes will replace these discontinued codes. Changes were also made to certain surgical codes if ASC providers are eligible to bill the code to reflect the current ASC group and its effective date. Also the professional/technical indicator was revised for several laboratory codes and the preoperative day indicator in the appendix (in the visit column) has been revised to coincide with an indicator in the CPT book for services that include the surgical procedure only.
