Pursuant to section 5111.873, and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, and 42 C.F.R. 447.205, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amended rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-41-11, entitled <u>Home and community-based waiver services -payment</u> for waiver services administered by the department of developmental disabilities. This rule establishes the payment standards governing reimbursement for home and community-based services (HCBS) provided by certified waiver providers to individuals enrolled in a HCBS program as a component of the Medicaid program and as administered by the Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) in accordance with sections 5111.85 and 5111.873 of the Revised Code. This rule is being amended to establish the payment standards for four new home and community-based waiver services.

Rule 5101:3-40-01, entitled <u>Medicaid home and community-based services program</u> <u>individual options waiver.</u> This rule establishes the individual options waiver as a component of the Medicaid home and community-based services program pursuant to sections 5111.85 and 5111.87 of the Revised Code. This rule is being amended to add four new home and communitybased waiver services.

The Department of Developmental Disabilities is proposing to add four new home and community-based services to the Individual Options waiver. The creation of the new services will allow more individuals access to beneficial programs that currently exist in Ohio. The services will allow for the use of technology to ensure an individual's health and safety in their residence and allow family members to have flexible alternatives. The DODD anticipates that the financial impact of these services will be minimal since the services will be used as an alternative to an existing waiver service. The Medicaid maximum rates for the proposed services will be established in rule 5101:3-41-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code and subject to the approval of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS).
