Rule 5101:3-41-05, entitled <u>Waiting lists for home and community-based services</u> <u>administered by the Ohio department of developmental disabilities.</u> This rule sets forth the requirements of a county board of developmental disabilities to establish and maintain a waiting list for home and community-based services. This rule is being proposed for rescission and a new rule under the same number is being proposed for adoption.

Rule 5101:3-41-08, entitled Free choice of provider requirements for Medicaid home and community-based services programs administered by the Ohio department of developmental disabilities. This rule sets for the requirements the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) must meet to assure free choice of provider.

Rule 5101:3-42-01, entitled <u>Medicaid home and community-based services program</u> <u>level one waiver</u>. This rule establishes the level one waiver as a component of the Medicaid home and community-based services program pursuant to sections 5111.87 and 5111.85 of the Revised Code.
