Pursuant to sections 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, and 42 CFR 447.205, the director of the Office of Medical Assistance (OMA) gives notice of the office's intent to consider the to consider the amendment of the rule identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-10-05 entitled "Reimbursement" is being proposed for amendment to To incorporate a federally mandated requirement contained in section 6407 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act regarding face-to-face encounters between consumers and prescribers of durable medical equipment (DME) equipment benefit. The changes to this rule include the following:

- Updated language pertaining to the dispensing of orthotic and prosthetic (O&P) supplies.
- A new provision requiring that prescriptions for certain DME and O&P items designated by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services must have originated as a result of a face-to-face encounter.
- Updated language regarding cost effective reimbursement.
- Updated language regarding reimbursement when the consumer expires prior to the dispensing of custom molded or fitted items.
- Updated language regarding the use of the RT (right side) and LT (left side) modifiers.

The office estimates that there is no fiscal impact resulting from these changes.
