Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-1-13.1, entitled <u>Medicaid Consumer Liability [except for consumers enrolled in Medicaid contracting managed care plans (MCPs)]</u>, is being proposed for five year rule review and to implement provisions of Am. Sub. HB 66 (Section 5111.0112 of the RC) establishing the need for Medicaid co-payments on dental, vision, non-emergency emergency department services and prescription medications.. The content of this rule explains a Medicaid consumer's liability of payment for services under the Medicaid program and explains that, when services are covered under the Medicaid program, Medicaid's payment is payment in full. Changes include adding additional costsharing provisions in paragraph (A) and also adding an additional provision under paragraph (C) directing providers to inform consumers that a service they must pay for may be received from another Medicaid provider at no cost to the consumer.
