

**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-1-01, entitled Medicaid: medical necessity, is being proposed for amendment for 5 year rule review, as well as to update and clarify policies relating to medical necessity. This rule sets forth the definition of medical necessity for the state of Ohio's medicaid program. The changes to the rule include correcting some spacing problems in the layout; correcting spelling, grammar and capitalization errors; and in paragraph (A) the term "services" has been changed to "medical services" for clarification.

Rule 5101:3-1-02, entitled General principles regarding reimbursement for medicaid covered services [except as provided through medicaid contracting managed care plans (MCPs)], is being proposed for amendment for 5 year rule review, as well as to update and clarify policies relating to reimbursement for medicaid covered services. The changes to the rule are to make a change in terminology, as well as to make clarifications. In (B)(2), the term "legal representative" is now more correctly termed as an "authorized representative." Paragraph (B)(3) now includes an explanation of the sources for habilitation services in Ohio Medicaid. In (B)(4), the term "provider" has been clarified by using the term "eligible provider."
