Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule as identified below and of public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-4-22, <u>Surgical services</u>, covers surgical services recognized under the Medicaid program. It outlines and defines billing procedures for different aspects of surgical codes and addresses how these differences affect reimbursement. It is being proposed for amendment to include changes meant to aid providers in billing for surgical services. It is also being proposed as part of the five-year rule review process.

The changes include the addition of the new appendix that will be available to clarify which surgical procedures are considered for bilateral pricing, multiple surgery pricing, and whether or not an assistant at surgery is reimbursable. In addition to this the Department will be adding the modifier '51' which can be used for billing multiple procedures. All other changes are for the clarification of existing policy.
