Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, and 42 CFR 447.205, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to amend the rule as identified below and of public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-4-12, entitled Immunizations, describes the Department's coverage of immunizations. It is being amended to add the vaccine code (90649) for human papilloma virus to the list of vaccines covered through the Vaccines for Children Program. Medicaid will be covering the vaccine for females age 11 through 18. The Department estimates that the coverage of this new vaccine will increase expenditures totaling \$53,000 on an annual basis to cover the administration fee for the vaccine that providers obtain through the Vaccine for Children program operated by the Ohio Department of Health. There is also a correction to the description of vaccine code 90734 in the VFC listing of covered vaccines in the rule.
