Pursuant to section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:3-10-10 entitled <u>Dialysis equipment</u> is being proposed for amendment for five year rule review. This rule codifies the current durable medical equipment (DME) requirements concerning the coverage criteria for dialysis equipment for dialysis conducted in a consumer's private residence. Minor changes to this rule include updating existing rule language relating to reimbursement for providers of dialysis equipment providing services to Ohio medicaid consumers currently receiving home dialysis and removing duplicative rule language that is presently codified in chapter 5101:3-1 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

Rule 5101:3-10-17 entitled <u>Blood glucose monitors (glucometers)</u> is being filed for rescission for five year rule review. This rule codifies the current durable medical equipment (DME) rules concerning the coverage criteria for blood glucose monitors.

Rule 5101:3-10-17 entitled <u>Blood glucose monitors (glucometers)</u> and <u>supplies</u> is being filed to replace the currently existing rule 5101:3-10-17. This rule sets forth the coverage criteria for blood glucose monitors and supplies dispensed to consumers of the Ohio medicaid program. A newly developed certificate of medical necessity/prescription JFS 01910 entitled "Blood Glucose Monitor (Glucometer) and Supplies" is being proposed to be used for prior authorization by providers dispensing blood glucose monitors with special features and specially designed supplies and materials to enable the visually impaired to use blood glucose monitor equipment without assistance.
