## LEGAL NOTICE

## STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES

Pursuant to Section 5111.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code and CFR 447.205, the Director of the Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to amend rule 5101:3-1-60.

Rule 5101:3-1-60 entitled "Medicaid reimbursement" contains a list of the codes and the reimbursement rates for these codes for non-institutional providers. The Department is amending this rule to discontinue certain HCPCS codes which are not H.I.P.A.A. compliant and will instruct providers to use standard CPT codes for these services. The Department is also discontinuing a local level modifier "ZP" which is not H.I.P.A.A. compliant and replacing it with methodology used by other payers to reimburse for anatomical laboratory services. Also, the Department reduced the prices of epoetin codes (Q codes) and certain J codes so Medicaid is not paying more than Medicare for these services. The department estimates that this amendment reduces aggregate expenditures by \$1.4 million for the next fiscal year.
