This rule outlines the process by which the Ohio Children's Trust Fund provides funding to local prevention advisory boards for child abuse and neglect prevention programs.

Rule 5101:5-1-02 entitled <u>Ohio children's trust fund and children's advocacy centers</u> is being proposed for adoption to comply with Senate Bill 66 of the 125<sup>th</sup> General Assembly. This rule outlines the process by which children's advocacy centers may request start-up funding from the Ohio Children's Trust Fund for primary prevention strategies as defined in section 3109.172 of the Revised Code.
