

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (DRC) hereby gives public notice of its intention to **amend** the following Administrative Rules:

- 5120-12-01 Establishment of a Transitional Control Program and Minimum Criteria Defining Eligibility**
- 5120-12-02 Screening, Selection, and Notice of Transfer**
- 5120-12-03 Transfer, Transportation, and Conditions of Supervision**
- 5120-12-04 Electronic Monitoring of Prisoners**
- 5120-12-05 Supervision Fees, Disbursement of Earnings, and Administration of the Transitional Control Fund**
- 5120-12-06 Issuance of Passes**
- 5120-12-07 Sanctions**
- 5120-12-08 Return to the Institution for Administrative Reasons**

The referenced rules govern the Transitional Control program, which transfers eligible inmates from the institution to halfway houses during the last 180 days of their prison term.

A public hearing will be held on the proposed rule in Conference Room 204, at 1050 Freeway Drive North, Columbus, Ohio, on **Wednesday, October 18, 2006**. Interested parties are invited to attend and comment for the record, which will be open at 1:30 p.m. and remain open for a time sufficient to receive comments. Copies of the rule will be available at the hearing or at the DRC Central Office (1050 Freeway Drive North) prior to the hearing.
