New Rule – (Certification Standards for Community Mental Health Agencies)

5122-26-191 Actual Uniform Cost Report Agreed Upon Procedures Review and Report Submission Requirement.

Establishes the requirement for all ODMH certified community mental health agencies that the actual uniform cost report (AUCR) submitted in accordance with rule 5122-26-19 of the Administrative Code was examined by an independent accounting firm using the agreed upon procedures contained in Appendix A of the rule prior to submission to ODMH.

Amended Rule - (Certification Standards for Community Mental Health Agencies)

5122-29-06 Partial Hospitalization Service

Defines the partial hospitalization service as a three hour per day schedule of activities. It previously was defined as a scheduled program that is available a minimum of three hours and up to a maximum of fourteen hours per day.

New Rule

5122:1-5-01 Annual Budget, Financial Reporting, and Independent Financial Audit Requirements

This rule establishes annual budget, financial reporting, and independent financial audit requirements for community mental health agencies certified by ODMH.
