PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on proposed changes to the following rule:

O.A.C. 5122-34-01 – Clinician loan repayment (currently entitled "Physician loan repayment")

OhioMHAS is undertaking the five-year review process for rule 5122-34-01. Due to amendments to R.C. 5119.185 enacted by H.B. 166 of the 133rd of the General Assembly, OhioMHAS is proposing to change this rule to expand its existing physician loan repayment program for physicians working in its regional psychiatric hospitals to also cover advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants working in those hospitals.

The public hearing will be held at 11 am on Thursday, March 7, 2024, in Room 3602 of the Rhodes State Office Tower located at 30 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 36th Floor.
