

**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID**

Pursuant to section 5164.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of Ohio Administration Code rule 5160-30-02 on a permanent basis and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5160-30-02, entitled "Coverage and limitation policies for alcohol and other drug treatment services" is being revised to include new services and medications covered by Medicaid when rendered by opiate treatment programs. This will increase access to these services and medications by those in need through a treatment protocol.

The adoption of this rule is estimated to increase expenditures for the Ohio Department of Medicaid no more than \$ 250,000 on an aggregate annual basis.

A public hearing on the proposed rule will be held at the date, time and location listed at the top of this notice. Both written and oral testimony will be taken at the public hearing. Written testimony submitted or postmarked no later than the date of the public hearing will be treated as testimony.
