Rule 5160-1-60.3, "Primary care physician rate increase," was adopted in response to a federal requirement that required Medicaid to increase payment to the Medicare rates for certain primary care services provided by physicians. The requirement was in effect from 1/1/2013 through 12/31/2014.

Because the requirement has sunset and is no longer in effect, the rule is being proposed for recession with an effective date of 1/1/2018.

The public hearing will be held at the date, time, and location listed at the top of this notice. Both written and oral testimony will be accepted at the public hearing, and written comments submitted or postmarked no later than the date of the public hearing will be treated as testimony.
