

**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Pursuant to Chapter 119. and section 5164.02 of the Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) gives notice of the Department's intent to file as the amended rule identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

**Rule 5160-43-02**, entitled Specialized Recovery Services Program Individual Eligibility, and Program Enrollment is being proposed as amended. This rule outlines the criteria for eligibility and enrollment in the Specialized Recovery Services Program and includes an updated appendix which lists all qualifying diagnoses. This rule was amended by removing the reference to being a recipient of disability benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act.

**Rule 5160-43-04**, entitled Specialized Recovery Services Program Covered Services and Provider Requirements is being proposed as amended. This rule describes the services an individual may receive while enrolled in the program, including individualized placement and support – supported employment (IPS-SE), peer recovery support, and recovery management. This rule also describes the recovery management services that are billable to Medicaid as well as the services that are not billable to Medicaid. This rule was amended in paragraph (D)(2) to include additional details for recovery managers regarding billing Medicaid for recovery management services.
