This rule is being proposed for amendment, to allow separate payment for medication-assisted treatment of opioid addiction, in addition to payment for an E&M service. The rendering provider must be a physician, certified nurse practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist who participates in an opioid treatment program (OTP) certified by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) of the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
