Pursuant to section 5164.02 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rule as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5160-4-06, "Specific provisions for evaluation and management (E&M) services," sets forth Medicaid coverage and payment policy for specific types of evaluation and management services (office visits). This rule is being proposed for amendment, to allow separate payment for medication-assisted treatment for the treatment of substance abuse disorder, including opioid use disorder, in addition to payment for an E&M service. The rendering provider must receive a waiver, as permitted under Section 303(g) (2) of the Drug Addiction Treatment Act of 2000 (DATA 2000) to treat opioid dependence in an office-based setting. DATA 2000 waivers permit certain rendering providers to treat opioid dependence without registering separately with the United States drug enforcement administration as an opioid treatment program.
