## Public Notice

The Department of Agriculture, State of Ohio, will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on proposed amendments to administrative rules 901:1-17-03, 901:1-1705, 901:1-17-06, 901:1-17-07, 901:1-17-08, and 901:1-17-10.

These rules set forth the requirements that dogs, cats and livestock, including animals imported for slaughter, must meet to be imported into Ohio. The proposed amendments are nonsubstantive. The amendments will change the cross references contained in the rules to various paragraphs in rule 901:1-17-02. The changes are necessary due re-lettering of the paragraphs in rule 901:1-17-02.

The hearing will be held Tuesday, March 1, 2005, at 8:45 a.m., in Hearing Room 133 (Seminar "B") Bromfield Administration Building, Ohio Department of Agriculture, 8995 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068-3399.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code. Any person affected by the proposed changes to the rules may appear and be heard in person, by his attorney, or both, may present his position, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the proposed changes, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
