

Public Notice

The Department of Agriculture, State of Ohio, will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on the proposed amendment of one rule: **901:5-52-02**, and the proposed adoption of one new rule: **901:5-52-08**.

These rules set out the application procedures, eligibility requirements and cost-sharing considerations for the voluntary gypsy moth suppression program, and add and revise definitions to support the proposed new rule. Authority for the amendment and adoption of these rules is found in Revised Code 927.52.

The hearing will be held on Tuesday, November 30, 2004 at 8:45 a.m., in Room 133 (Training Room 'B') Bromfield Administration Building, Ohio Department of Agriculture, 8995 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068-3399.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code. Any person affected by this rulemaking may appear and be heard in person, by his attorney, or both, may present her position, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the proposed amendment and adoption, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
