## **Public Notice**

The Department of Agriculture, State of Ohio, will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on the proposed rescission of one rule: 901:5-11-13, the amendment of two rules: 901:5-11-02 and 901:5-11-10, and the adoption of two rules: 901:5-11-13 and 901:5-11-99.

These rules pertain to recordkeeping requirements for commercial applicators conducting wood-destroying insect diagnostic inspections, and include a new form to be used in reporting those inspection findings. In addition, the rule governing civil penalties for violations of the Ohio Pesticide Law is being renumbered. Authority for the rescission, amendment and adoption of these rules is found in Revised Code 921.16.

The hearing will be held Friday, December 10, 2004, at 9:00 a.m., in Room 133 (Training Room 'B') Bromfield Administration Building, Ohio Department of Agriculture, 8995 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068-3399.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code. Any person affected by this rulemaking may appear and be heard in person, by his attorney, or both, may present her position, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the proposed rescission, amendment, and adoption, if effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
