## **Public Notice**

The Ohio Department of Agriculture will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on Electronic Amusement Games as they relate to section 901:9-2 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

These rules relate to the Division of Amusement Ride Safety. The rules were reviewed pursuant to 119.32 of the Revised Code. The following amendments are up for review. The amendment to rule 901:9-2-01 creates a definition for "electronic amusement game" as used in 901:9-2-16. Amendments made to rule 901:9-2-02 include a revocation of the May 31<sup>st</sup> review deadline for all games to be reviewed by the department. Rule 901:9-2-16 removes ambiguity by utilizing the "electronic amusement game definition as proposed in 901:9-2-01.

The hearing will be held May 6, 2014 at 10:00 a.m., in Hearing Room 133 (Seminar "B") Bromfield Administration Building, Ohio Department of Agriculture, 8995 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068-3399.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code. Any person affected by the no change rule package may appear and be heard in person, by his attorney, or both, may present his position, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the no change rule package, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
