A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held at Ohio EPA, 50 West Town Street, Columbus, Ohio in Conference Room A, on December 6, 2017 at 10:30am.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, (614) 644-2160. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rulemaking.

Written testimony should be sent to the attention of Karen Hale, Division of Environmental Response and Revitalization (DERR), P.O. Box 1049, Columbus Ohio 43216-1049. Written comments may also be submitted to the Hearing Officer at the public hearing. Written testimony will receive the same consideration as oral testimony. All testimony received at the hearing or by close of business on December 6, 2017 will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rulemaking proposal. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.

## DERR Haz Waste Set O Rules Hearing

My name is Mary McCarron. I will be presiding over today's public hearing.

Thank you for taking time to attend this hearing before Ohio EPA. The purpose of the hearing today is to obtain comments from any interested person regarding Ohio EPA's proposed rules.

Ohio EPA Division of Environmental Response and Revitalization is proposing to amend the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code 3745-50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 65, 66, 67, 68, 266, 270 and 273. These rules address requirements of the hazardous waste program and are typically referred to as Set O.

These rules have been filed with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented, and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rules. All written and oral comments received as part of the official record will be considered by the director of Ohio EPA before a final decision is made.
