## **Consolidated Summary of Comments Received**

On September 17, 2018 the Ohio Hospital Association (OHA) submitted testimony to the Ohio Department of Medicaid (Department) supporting the revision of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 5160-2-08.1. OHA stated they are supportive of the Department's efforts to decrease any burden related to the Hospital Care Assurance Program (HCAP) by setting an assessment rate cap of 1.5% for a hospital's adjusted total facility costs up to \$216,372,500 and 1% for any amount over \$216,372,500. OHA also stated they appreciate the flexibility this rule will create to increase the assessment on hospitals should new funds become available for HCAP. OHA stated they understand the Department will not assess hospitals more than what is needed to administer the HCAP program. Lastly, OHA stated they recommend the Department move forward with the adoption of this rule as proposed.
