Trumbull County Children Services (TCCS) commented that while they appreciated earlier changes made by ODJFS as a result of stakeholder comment, the rule could be further enhanced by the following:

- Additing language establish mandatory time frames for the initiation and completion of complaint investigations.
- Adding a requirment that the Paragraph C notification be provided in writing and include the date that the complaint was received, a description of the allegation(s), and a summary of the specific rules that the agency/ facility allegedly violated.

TCCS argued that the new language would improve the complaint handling process by increasing accountability, transparency, and communication.
