Re: Memorandum of Response to CSI Review – Consumer Products (OAC Chapter 3745-112)

On September 6, 2012, Ohio EPA received the Recommendations for the Consumer Products (OAC Chapter 3745-112) Rule Package.

The CSI memorandum stated that “Ultimately, the rules are intended to help reduce emissions of volatile compounds which can adversely affect public health, and also represent a part of the State Implementation Plan required by the U.S. EPA. As such, and without any feedback from businesses that the rules are overly burdensome, the CSI Office finds that the intent of the regulations justifies the adverse impacts to business. For the reasons discussed above, the CSI Office does not have any recommendations for this rule package. Based on the above comments, the CSI Office concludes that the Ohio EPA should proceed with the formal filing of this rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.”

At this time, it is Ohio EPA’s plan to move forward with the original filing of this rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.
