Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for the draft rules pertaining to online driver education under Chapter 4501-7 of the OAC. The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS), has received and read your review, recommendations, and conclusions.
