On November 8, 2013, the Ohio Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board (“Board”) received the Common Sense Initiative Office’s Recommendation Memorandum (“CSI Recommendation”) for the 2014 OT Licensure Changes (OAC 4755-3-09; 4755-3-11; 4755-5-11; and 4755-7-10) rule package. The Board appreciates the timely issuance of this memo.
