Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Chapter 4765-20 of the Administrative Code. The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS), has received and read your reviews, recommendations, and conclusions.

By mid-January 2014, the Division of EMS intends to formally file Chapter 4765-20 of the Administrative Code and all required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review and the Legislative Service Commission. The Division of EMS plans to conduct a public hearing pursuant to R.C. 119.03 in February 2014 at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Room C4-8, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus Ohio, 43223. The Division of EMS anticipates final-filing the rules with an effective date of April 30, 2014.
