Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for the drafted rules pertaining to Remedial Driving Courses under Chapter 4501-21, which included rules 4501-21-01, 4501-21-02, 4501-21-04, 4501-21-05, 4501-21-06, 4501-21-08, 4501-21-12, 4501-21-13, and 4501-21-15 of the OAC.
