Thank you for your timely review of the business impact analysis for rules 4501:1-3-01 and 4501:1-3-02 (Used Motor Vehicle Dealer Training) of the Administrative Code. The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV), has received and read your review, recommendations, and conclusions.

The Ohio Department of Public Safety intends to file rules 4501:1-3-01 and 4501:1-3-02 and required materials on behalf of the BMV with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review and the Legislative Service Commission, when all vacant positions of the Motor Vehicle Dealer Licensing Board (Board) have been appointed and a quorum can be present in order to conduct a public hearing for the two rules, pursuant to R.C. 119.03.
