Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Chapter 4501-7 of the Administrative Code (driver training schools). The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, Driver Training Program has received and read your review and recommendations, and conclusions.

On September 16, 2014, The Office of Criminal Justice Service, Driver Training Program intends to formally file Chapter 4501-7 of the Administrative Code and all the required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review and the Legislative Service Commission. The Office of Criminal Justice Service, Driver Training Program plans to conduct a public hearing for the rules proposed for amendment pursuant to R.C. 119.03 on October 24, 2014 at 10am at the Ohio Department of Transportation, Room GB, 1980 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223.
