Re:	PUCO Response – Safety Standards for Motor Carriers, Contained in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:2-5

The Public Utilities Commission (PUCO) issued a final Finding and Order on May 14, 2014, amending nine rules, making no change to one rule, proposing two new rules, and rescinding one rule. On July 21, 2014, CSI replied to the PUCO, stating that it had no recommendations for the rule package and that the PUCO should proceed to file the rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR). Rehearing requests for the PUCO's May 14, 2014 Finding and Order were due by June 13, 2014, pursuant to R.C. 4903.10. No parties filed for rehearing. Therefore, the PUCO will proceed and file these rules with JCARR.
