Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Chapter 4765-8 and Chapter 4765-9 of the Administrative Code. The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS), has received and read your reviews, recommendations, and conclusions. EMS understands that you have no recommended changes.

By mid-January 2016, the Division of EMS intends to formally file Chapter 4765-8 and Chapter 4765-9 of the Administrative Code and all required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review and the Legislative Service Commission. The Division of EMS plans to conduct a public hearing pursuant to R.C. 119.03 in February 2016 at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223. The Division of EMS anticipates final-filing the amended Chapter 4765-9 rules in March 2016 with an effective date of April 14, 2016.
